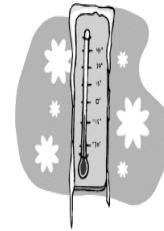

## Science Fair Information

It may feel early, but it is time for 4th, 5th and 6th graders to get started on a Science Fair project. Here are some important rules and regulations you should be aware of *before* pulling out the goggles and lab coats.

First, before experimenting, **you MUST complete a registration form and get prior approval.** These forms are from the Salt Lake Valley Science and Engineering Fair (SLVSEF), but are required to participate at the school and district level. You can research, outline your procedure and even gather materials, but you cannot begin the experiment until it is approved. This is for the safety of the child and anyone helping them with their project.

- Registration forms are due by 1/13
- Projects are due by 1/25
- Science Night is on 1/26
- Judging is on 1/27
