4th - 6th grades start your Science Fair Project Read these rules before you start so you don't get disqualified. **DO NOT EXPERIMENT UNTIL YOU REGISTER AND GET APPROVAL.** Gather your materials and get ready, but don't begin until you know it's approved.

1. Make a Science Fair Journal. Use a composition notebook with pages that don't tear out. Write in pen. Make a detailed Table of Contents on the first two pages. Number your pages.
2. Do research. Read from more than 3 different sources (books, web/magazine articles, encyclopedia, etc.). Site your sources using bibliography format.
3. Mold, bacteria, and other pathogens cannot be grown at home! If you want to work with them, talk to Mrs. Lane.
4. No demonstrations (e.g. a volcano).

Register by Friday 01/15, turn in projects by Wednesday 01/27.
Family Science Night is Thursday 01/28, judging is Friday 01/29.
