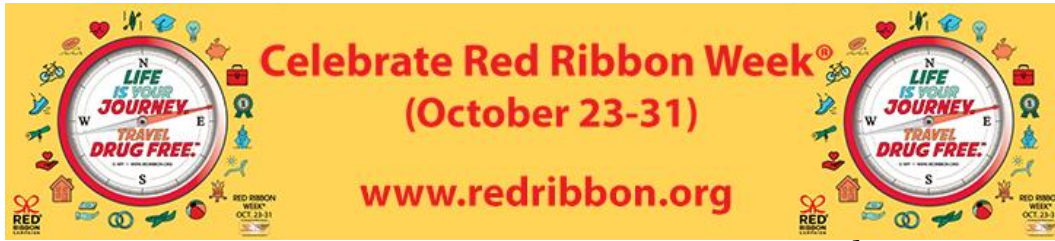

**Getting to school on time is a family matter.** Parents and students must work together to make timely attendance a priority. Go to bed at a decent hour every night. Wake up 30 minutes earlier. Don't watch TV in the morning. Change your carpool if others are making you late. Prepare your lunch, backpack, and even breakfast the night before so you aren't scrambling to get ready.

**What is Daylight Saving Time?** Daylight Saving Time (DST) is the practice of moving the clocks forward one hour from Standard Time for the summer months, and changing them back again in the fall. The general idea is that this allows us all to make better use of natural daylight.



**DST ends on Sunday, November 4, 2018, at 2:00 A.M.** At this time, we "fall back" in the fall by setting clocks back one hour (i.e., gaining one hour). *Note: Since the time changes at 2:00 A.M., we generally change our clocks at Saturday bedtime.* Learn more here: <https://www.almanac.com/content/when-daylight-saving-time>
