School Community Council Meeting Minutes

Welcome/Introduction – Nathan Elkins

In Attendance: Nathan Elkins, Dan Pahl, Norma Pahl, Idamae Hawthorn, Kim Hill, Eric Safir, Shelly Safir.

Principal's Report – Nathan Elkins

- School Improvement Plan – now referred to as the Excellence in Equity Plan (EEP).
- The School Improvement Committee (SIC) and School Community Council (SCC) work together to create the SIP/EEP. Which is difficult to do without knowing the End of Level information.
- Where do we want to be in the next 3 years? SCC is one avenue of parental input. Safety is also a factor, not just academics. We also have to consider what the students want. Mr. Elkins has considered establishing a "Student Council" type of group to get student's feedback.
- Land Trust – In previous years, we have paid for a teacher and a portion of the P.E. ParaProfessional. At the March meeting, we will be voting on how we want to use next year's funding.
- Staffing is based on student enrollment (Average Daily Membership). That is what determines how many teachers we can have. Kindergarten – 3rd grade can have 25 students/classroom. 4-6th grade can have 28 students/classroom.
- Mr. Elkins discussed Discretionary Funds/Title 1/School Improvement Fund/Title 3 funds – what funding can be used to pay for teachers as well. Enrollment & Budgets are decreasing, which means we'll need to decrease staff. The SIC recommends unassigning one Kinder teacher, one 1st grade as well as one 3rd grade teacher for the 2018-2019 school year.

School Community Council Vice Chairperson – Idamae Hawthorn

- Traffic seems to be flowing better out front in the drop off/bus loading zone. Haven't had any negative feedback at this point. Will continue to set up the cones.
